Make sure your application is complete before mailing, as incomplete packets will not be reviewed. The following checklist is provided for your convenience. Each packet must include each of the following:
Racial/Ethnic Minority Graduate Scholarship Application (complete and print the application and send it in with the rest of your application);
an Official Transcript with seal from the student's Graduate Program Registrar (digital transcripts will not be accepted);
Resume or Curriculum Vitae;
Three letters of recommendation addressing the student's work and progress in program, including one from the student's dissertation Advisor. The letter from the Advisor should address the financial need of the applicant, and should also note that the student will have defended the dissertation proposal and have achieved advanced status in the doctoral program (completed course work, examinations, and approval of their dissertation prospectus) by the end of the Spring 2017 academic year.
Each letter should be placed in a sealed envelope <i>with author's signature over the seal</i> . Letters not included in the packet will not be accepted. It is the candidate's responsibility to make sure that all letters of recommendation are signed over the flap by the authors of the letters and included in the application packet.
