The previous year has been a “gearing up” year for the Justice 21 Committee. All activities were handled electronically, and the Committee did not meet in person. Activities included: reflection on the experience of producing the 2012 *Agenda for Social Justice*, and discussing future improvements for dissemination of the 2016 *Agenda*. The *Agenda* is available for free download via the Society’s web site, and tracking of “hits” indicates a global reach for our publication. In addition, the 2012 *Agenda* is available for a nominal price from Amazon in both electronic (i.e., Kindle) and paperback (i.e., print-on-demand) formats. In the coming year, the items of the Committee’s agenda will be organizing the early stages for the 2016 *Agenda* and inviting/soliciting contributions for the 2016 *Agenda*.
