Between July 2018 and July 2019, the listserv membership increased from 290 to 291. Listserv subscriptions remained low, but steady throughout the year, with the largest numbers of listserv subscriptions in March of 2019 at 6 subscriptions.

As with previous years, postings and discussions on the listserv remained low. Moderating the listserv continues to be a simple task, with less than 10 new members needing to be added each month.

After comments from a member that it was difficult to unsubscribe from the listserv, I worked with the Administrative Office to address some of the user-side components of listserv interaction including not only clarifying the unsubscribe feature, but also the welcome message and a website description of listserv use.

To clarify the unsubscribe process, we elected to include a footer on all listserv messages to ensure that listserv members could easily unsubscribe or contact the listserv moderator with questions:

Unsubscribe footers such as these are common on many other listservs.

We elected to simplify and shorten the welcome message received by listserv subscribers. The new message now contains shorter and more user-friendly directions for how to post to the listserv, how to unsubscribe from the listserv, and how to access the listserv archives. A copy of the new listserv message is attached at the end of this report.

All of these changes were made with the hope to make the listserv a more user-friendly tool for our members, setting the best foundation for use of the listserv.

I will continue my tenure as Listserv Moderator until the 2020 Annual Meeting.
