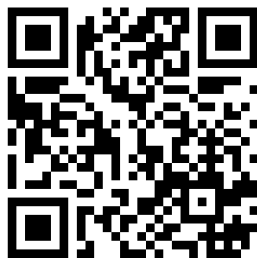
Posters should address SSSP's stated purpose:

- Poster title
- Research methodology (as applicable)
- Citation list
- A brief description of the study and findings
